

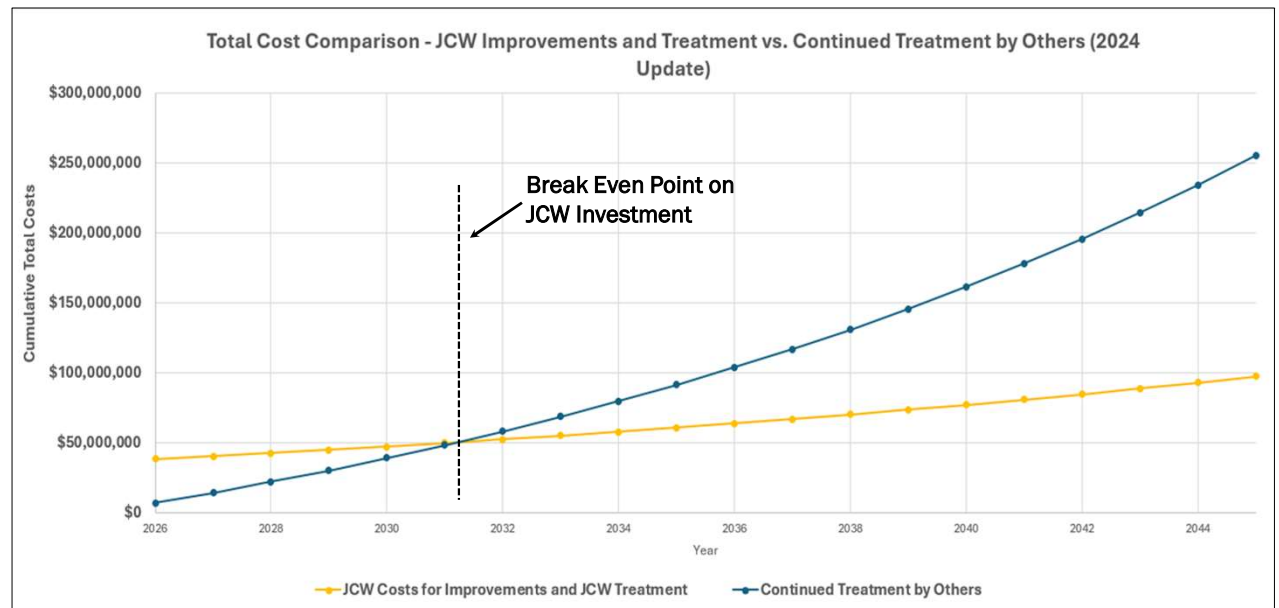

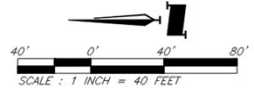

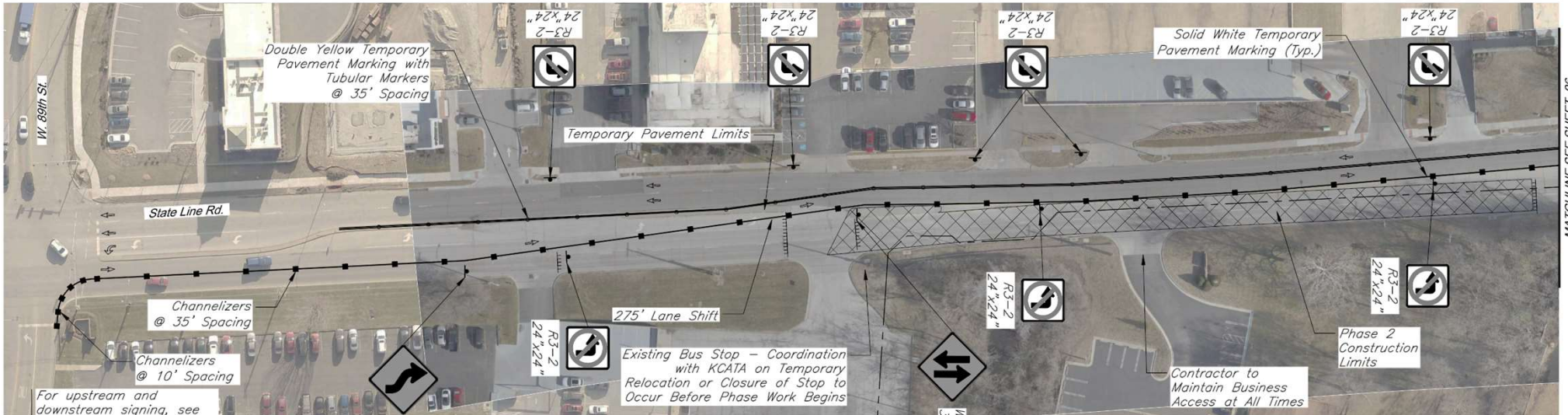
*Tubular Marker Detail

Note: Tubular markers shall be installed at 5' spacing from 5' upstream to 5' downstream of driveways and access drives where left turns are temporarily restricted.



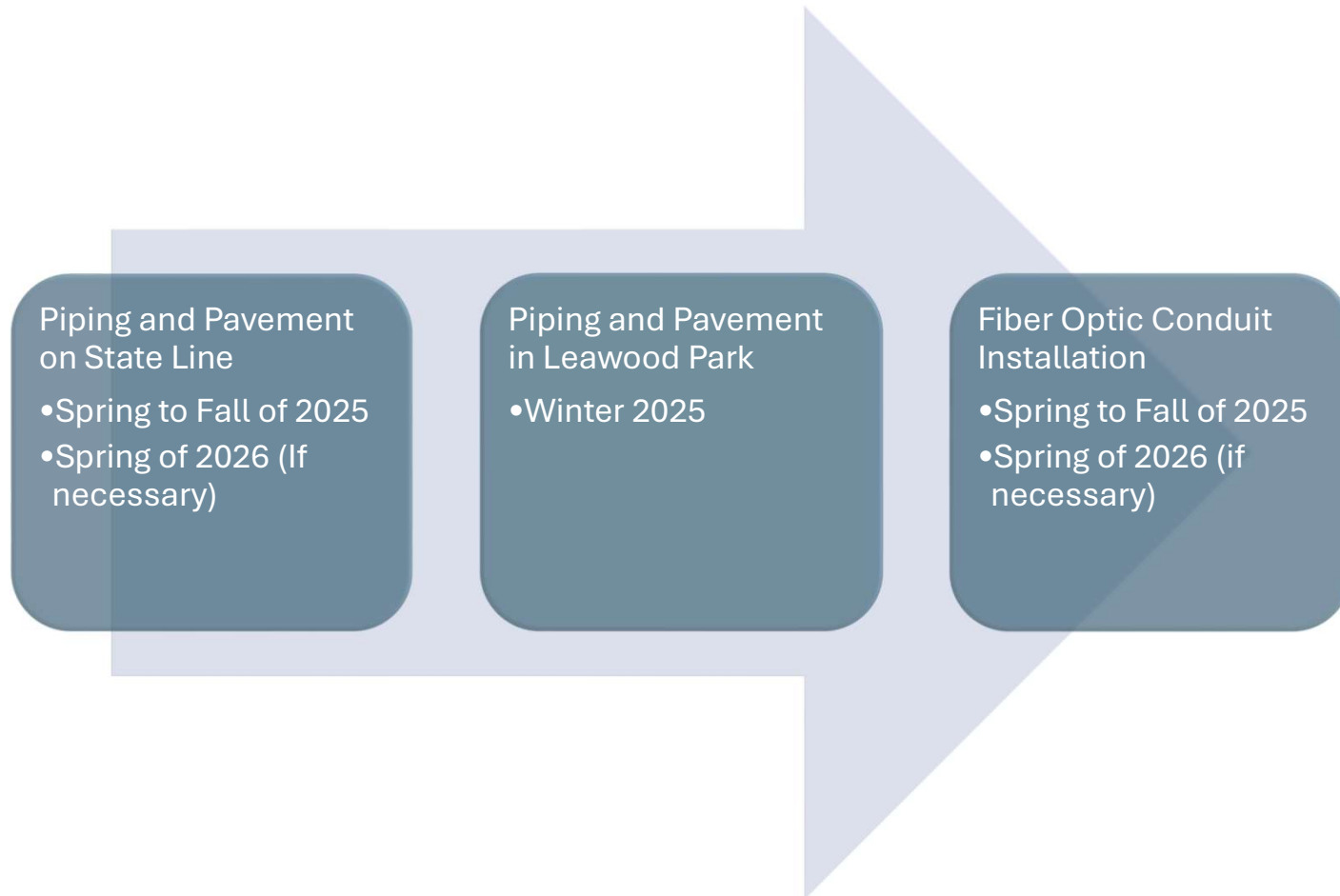
Note: For all phases during construction, the Contractor shall maintain access to all residential driveways at all times when work is not actively occurring which requires access restrictions. Contractor shall inform property owners at least 3 days in advance, in writing, when such access restrictions will occur, and shall minimize the duration of the access restrictions to the greatest extent feasible.

*Note: Outside southbound lane closure north of W. 89th Street signal.

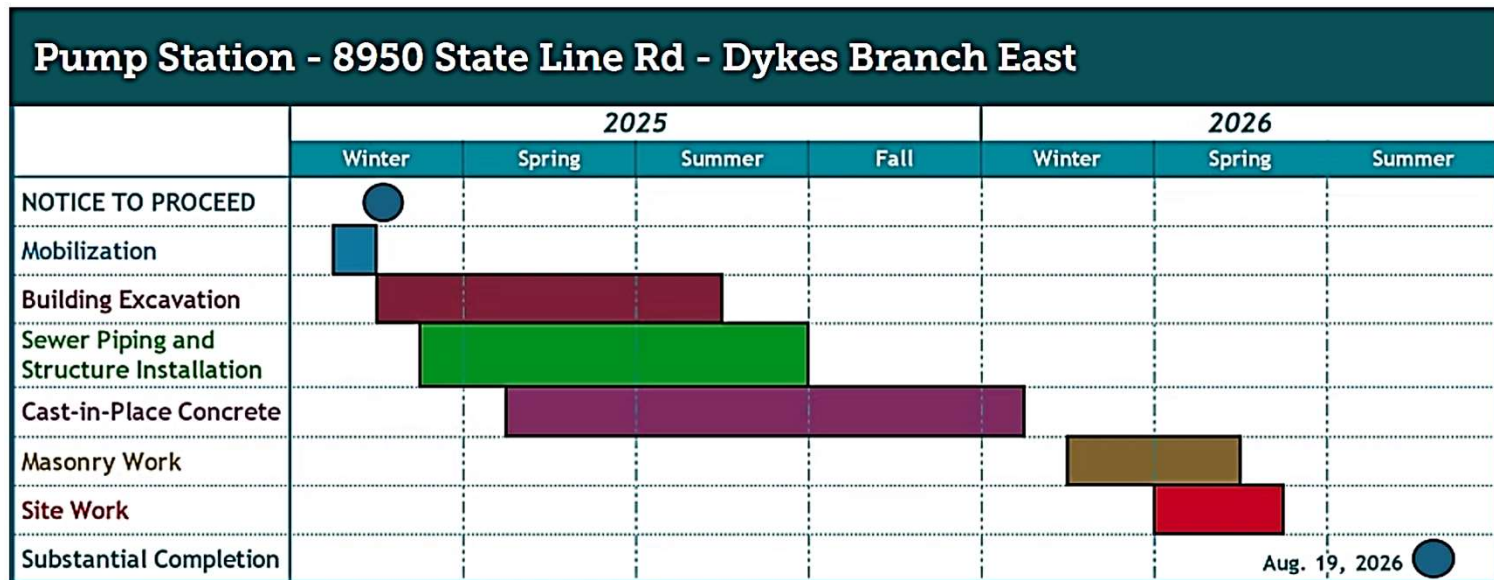

The schedules shown above are approximate as the City and Rodriguez are currently refining the Traffic Control Plans.

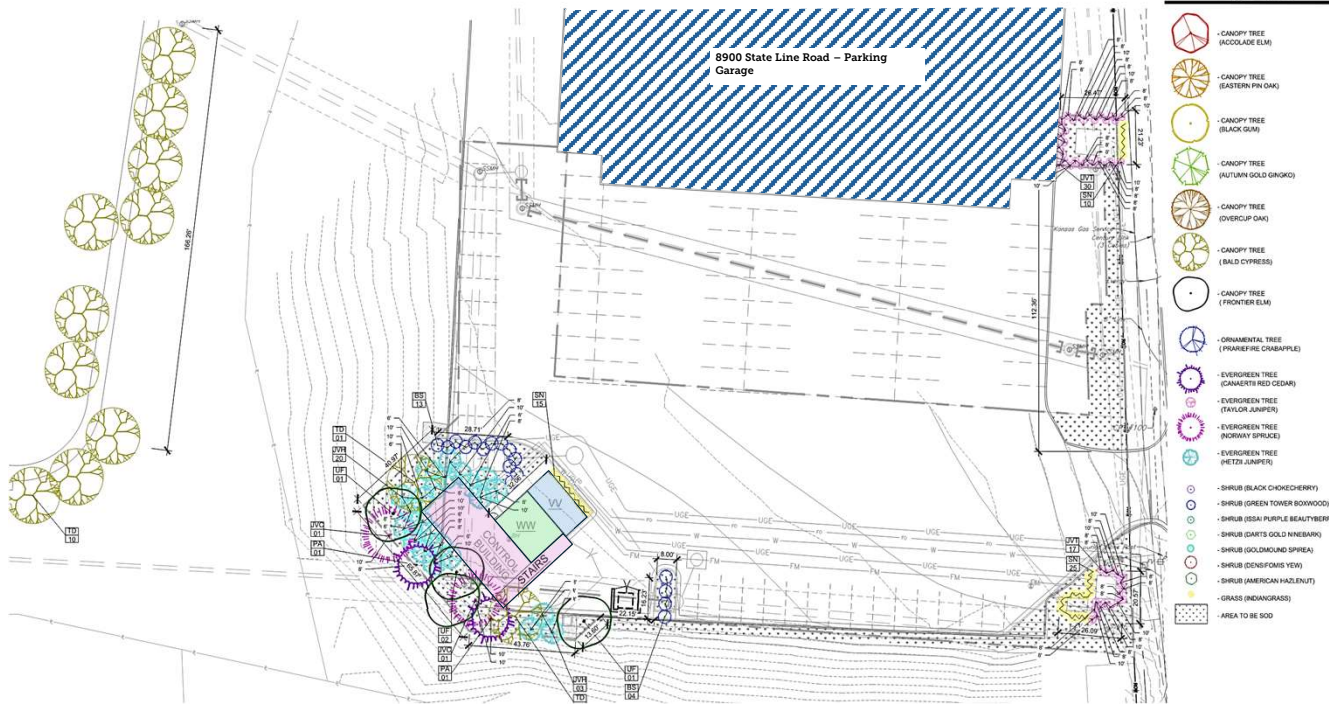

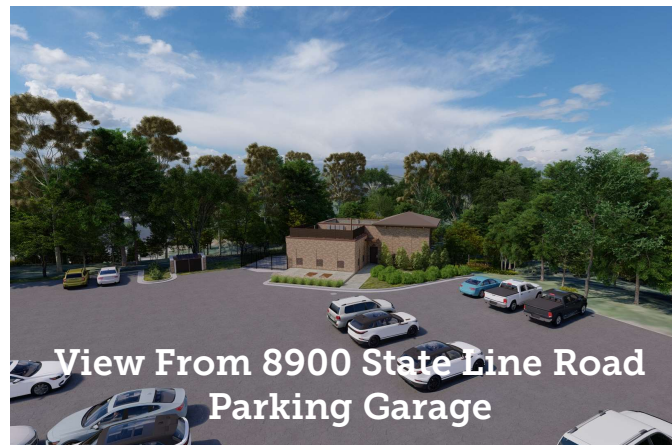

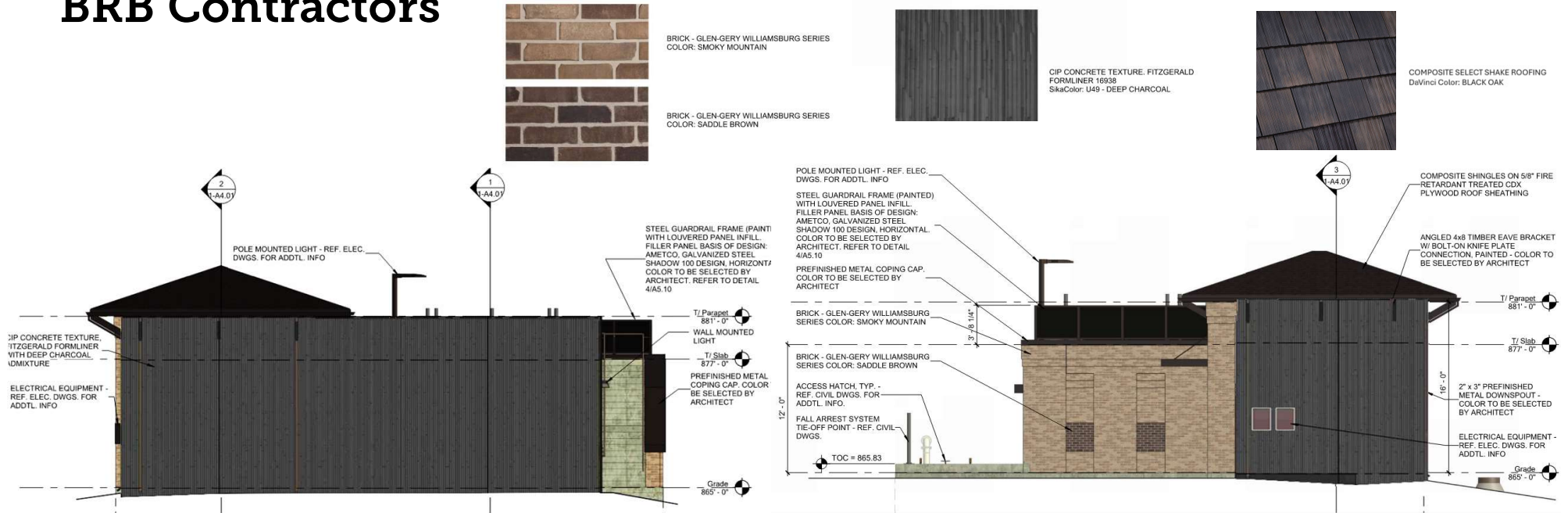


Landscaping Plan with Varied Tree Heights

Renderings After Construction with New Plantings

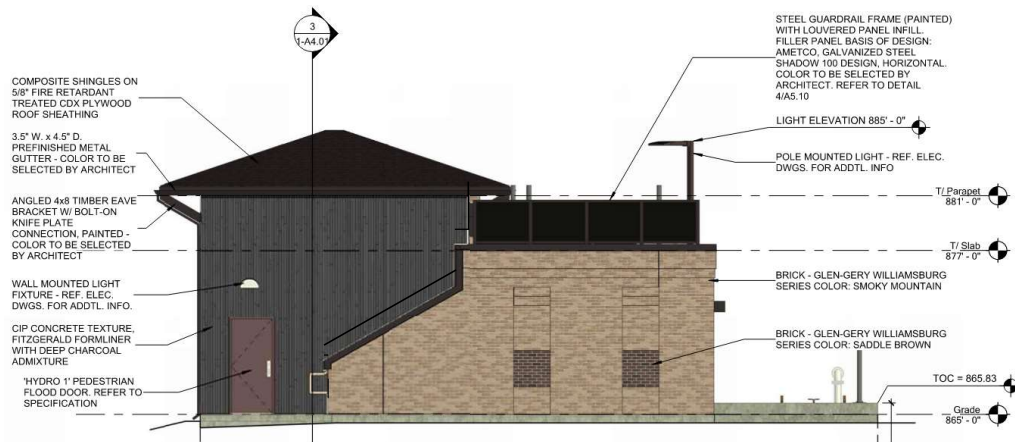
